Miss Supertest III III

Come and see this Canadian Icon race boat up close. Designed and built by Canadians in 1959, it is the only three time winner of the Harmsworth Trophy. First awarded in 1903, the Harmsworth has long been recognized as the world championship of power boat racing. Undefeated in her career, Miss Supertest III won the 1959,1960 and 1961 Harmsworth Trophy races, breaking a 39 year long American stranglehold on the coveted trophy. The successful conquest by Miss Supertest followed unlimited power boat racing achievements by both Rainbow and Miss Canada series of boats from Muskoka in earlier decades.

Peggy 's Passions Jewelry

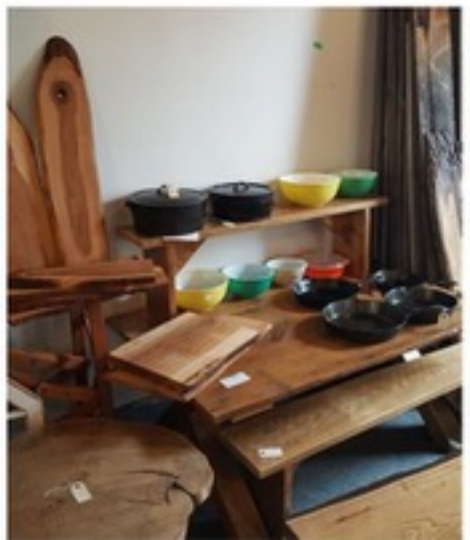
